Dear Siblings in Christ,

I keep praying and seeking ways we can witness to the love of God and be a blessing to others. One idea that I have been thinking about is a "Blessing Box." There are many variations on what a Blessing Box can be. One way that these have been used is as a little free pantry, like the Little Free Libraries we see around. I wonder if this might be something that would be beneficial in our community. Would a Blessing Box, stocked with essentials for hygiene, shelf stable food, and other basic needs help to support the community, while we also offer information for additional or ongoing support (for example: Food Pantry dates, Diaper Depot information, etc.) be of benefit – is it something we might be willing to try?

Stemming from this idea of a blessing box that would be on St. Luke's property, I also found ideas of Blessing Bags. These could be gallon-sized Ziplock bags that we assemble with basic care items and snacks that we would be able to keep in our cars and hand out to those in need who we cross along our path. Instead of driving by the person with a sign on the corner needing help, we could give a bag with items to show God's love, to show that we see them and that they are valued. Or maybe we keep notecards with inspirational messages handy to give to someone who seems to be having a down day.

I like the idea of us gathering to build kits to then be shared as blessings in our daily excursions with others. Taking a moment to share God's love, to let someone know that they are loved, and that we are here to help and support, to pray, and to love the people of God. If this is something you think you might be interested in, let me know, and let's see how we can be a visible blessing to others.


