

THE ST. LUKE LETTER April 2025

Dear Siblings in Christ,

As the season of Lent ends this month, we find ourselves standing at the threshold of Easter. The weeks of repentance, reflection, forgiveness, and renewal have led us through the wilderness, where we have examined our hearts, acknowledged our need for God's grace, and prepared for the joyous proclamation of resurrection.

Lent calls us into a time of self-examination and discipline, a period where we are reminded of our human frailty and our deep need for God's mercy. Whether through fasting, prayer, offering forgiveness, or acts of service, we have been invited to walk with Christ on the road to the cross. In doing so, we have confronted sorrow and sacrifice, longing for the hope that lies beyond.

And now, as Holy Week approaches, we prepare to witness again the greatest act of love the world has ever known. The cross looms large before us, a stark reminder of the cost of sin, but also of the immeasurable depth of God's love. Jesus' journey to the cross is not the end of the story, but the beginning of something new.

Near the end of this month, we find ourselves on Easter morning, when the light of the resurrection breaks through the darkness. The tomb is empty, and death has been defeated! The hope we have longed for throughout Lent bursts forth in the risen Christ, who calls us to new life in him. What began in reflection now turns to rejoicing, as we proclaim with confidence: Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

St. Luke's Spiritual Relations Committee has been planning in person services for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday for 7:00 pm each evening. In the past we have done services with foot washing, Tenebrae, and other traditionally Lutheran settings. This year we are using a slightly different format and finding inspiration from a Tenebrae service written by Joseph Martin called *The Solemn Shadows: A Service for Tenebrae*. Martin's music will be split between the two services providing a backdrop for reflection and gratitude. For each musical piece we have an accompanying slideshow. Between the songs we will have interactive tables for folks to visit. Thursday evening will include Holy Communion and end with the stripping of the altar. Friday's service will include a Bidding Prayer and end with a modified Procession of the Cross Liturgy.

<u>Lent & Easter Project</u>—The Community Relations Committee Lent and Easter Project in 2025 is collecting items for Lutheran World Relief Personal Care Kits through Easter Sunday, April 20th. We are asking the Congregation to collect items for these kits as a way to help out with

the recent disasters in our country. You are asked to purchase all the items for an individual Personal Care Kit (or kits) and place them in a plastic bag and then place each bag in the collection bin that is located in the narthex. The Community Relations Committee will assemble the kits after Easter. There are pictures on the collection bin to give you an idea of what the kits look like. **The items needed for each Personal Care Kit are:**

- -1 light-weight bath-size towel (20"x40" to 52"x27") in a dark color
- -2 bath size soap bars (4oz to 5 oz)—keep in original package
- -1 adult-size toothbrush—keep in original package
- -1 sturdy comb—packing removed
- -1 metal nail clipper—packaging removed

FOOD PANTRY: The Centre Hall/Penns Valley Food Pantry is located in the lower level of Grace United Methodist Church. The monthly distribution day is the Third Tuesday of each month from 1:30-3pm except for August when it is held the second Tuesday. In case of an emergency, a coordinator can always be contacted for a food distribution. The next monthly food distribution will be held on **Tuesday, April 15, 2025**, at Grace United Methodist Church, Centre Hall. Volunteers are needed to pack and distribute boxes from **8:00am-4:00 pm**.

Now that the Food Pantry is serving all of Penns Valley, the monthly need more than doubled. We are now serving over 110 families so any help you could provide would be greatly appreciated. The most needed items typically remain shelf stable items like canned goods, cereals, pastas, etc.; however, there is an emphasis item each month that is listed below. If you would like to make a donation, please place non-perishable items in the designated Food Pantry Box located in the narthex at St. Luke Lutheran

Church on or before **Sunday**, **April 13**, **2025**. You may also make a monetary donation by specifying a designated amount on your offering envelope, by making a check payable to St. Luke with "Food Pantry" in the memo line and placing it in the offering plate, or by placing a cash donation in an envelope in the offering plate that is specially marked for Food Pantry.
